After God created humankind, he walked and talked with Adam and Eve in the garden every day. They had a great relationship. The first people lacked for nothing. The only warning God gave them was to not eat the fruit from one particular tree. Amazingly, both the first man and woman ate the only forbidden fruit.

Starting with Adam and Eve, men and women have all sinned. We have done things that God specifically asked us not to do. Doing those things causes a rift in our relationship with our perfect Father. **Sin separates** us from God. It causes us to fear God and to live our lives outside of our true purpose.

But, being his children - God is not content to allow the relationship to stay broken. God the Father sent His Son, Jesus to break the power of sin and death by dying on the cross in our place for our sin. He took the initiative to re-establish the relationship between us and Himself. Now we are invited to accept what He has done for us. When we rekindle that relationship, we call it **salvation**.

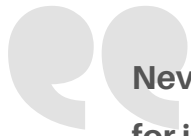

The word Helper is (paraklEtos) which means, "one that comes beside you." It is important to understand in that the Holy Spirit is not behind us to push us or in front to control us in anyway.

For they heard them speak with tongues and magnify God. Then Peter answered, "Can anyone forbid water, that these should not be baptized who have received the Holy Spirit just as we have?"

And it happened, while Apollos was at Corinth, that Paul, having passed through the upper regions, came to Ephesus. And finding some disciples He said to them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" So they said to him, "We have not so much as heard whether there is a Holy Spirit." And he said to them, "Into what then were you baptized?" So they said, "Into John's baptism." Then Paul said, "John indeed baptized with a baptism of repentance, saying to the people that they should believe on Him who would come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus." When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied. While we have seen many, many miracles take place at Refuge Church; a normal question is "why isn't everyone healed?" **Truthfully, we don't know.** God decides. Sometimes we will see immediate healing the first time we ask. Sometimes it's not until someone is called home to heaven that we know they are completely healed. The fact that some are not healed does not destroy the fact that God can and does heal.

Refuge Church started life as **Full Gospel Tabernacle** in Klamath Falls, 1954. In 1962 the name was officially changed to **Faith Tabernacle** under Pastor Bigby. We have a legacy of amazing pastors and believers who have made a real difference in the Klamath Basin for over six decades!
